A detailed description of an Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO) assessment and how it is mapped to *The Ontario Curriculum*

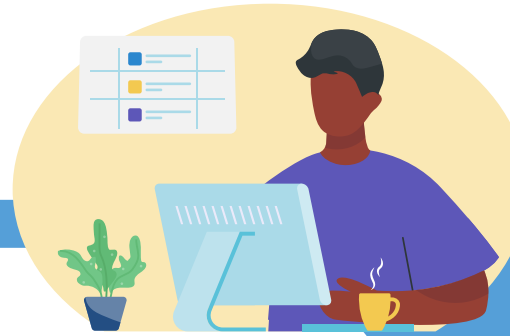
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Who Are Frameworks For?

- The Assessment of Reading, Writing and Mathematics, Junior Division (Grade 6)
- The Grade 9 Assessment of Mathematics
- The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test (OSSLT; Grade 10)

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What Is Included in the Frameworks?

- A description of what is assessed on the online test
- The assessment's process and design
- The blueprint, or a description of how curriculum expectations are reflected in the assessments
- An explanation of how student achievement is reported and scored
